### Youth Packing List:

- Medication (given to a leader as appropriate)

- 1 or 2 pair of jeans (cool evenings)
- Sweatshirt or light jacket
- 3 pairs of shorts
- 4 t-shirts (light colored)
- 4 pair underwear and socks
- Pajamas (or shorts and t-shirt)
- Swimsuit for in the shower
- Ditty Bag: deodorant, soap, shampoo, brush, toothbrush and toothpaste, towel, washcloth, insect repellent, personal hygiene products, sunscreen
- Hat
- Raincoat / Poncho
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Pen and notebook (for speakers)
- Flashlight and batteries
- Camera and film
- Water bottle (for @ campsite and concerts)
- Blanket to sit on at the concerts
- Camp-chair to sit on for meals
- \$ for T-shirts, CD's, snacks (\$25-50)
- Optional: cards, travel board games, water balloons, squirtguns, balls, etc.

### Schedule and Basic Rules:

- DEPARTURE: Meet at Lititz UMC at 8am on Wednesday, June 28, 2017. We will pack and then leave at about 8:30am
- ARRIVAL HOME: We will leave Creation on Sunday morning. We will arrive back to Lititz UMC at about 11:45am on Sunday morning.
  - Group Texts will update parents on Arrival and Departure Times
- Contact info for chaperones is listed below—and a link is provided to CreationFest website with info and directions
  - Each youth should already have paid their **\$100--to be paid ASAP if not already.**
- The rest of the trip will come out of the Youth Budget. This money covers admission, food, and supplies.
- Youth will check in with Jason and other leaders at each meal and before breaking off to go to other concerts.
  - Youth will take turns helping with meals, cleaning, etc. as assigned by leaders.
- Youth are required to attend: all 3 meals, the morning worship and both morning speakers, 1 speaker of choice during the afternoon session, as well as the evening concerts and speakers at the mainstage.
  - Quiet Time begins at 1am—2am lights out and silence – 7am rise and shine.
- Youth must stay in groups of at least three at all times and must let Jason know where you are going and when you'll be back.
  - No non-Christian music is permitted; No drugs, alcohol, or tobacco; no fireworks or weapons, and no offensive clothing or reading material.

- Any youth who misbehaves, or fails to listen to an adult leader will (at the discretion of the youth director and chaperones) be required to have a parent come and pick them up.
- Youth are required to demonstrate a Christian attitude of love, graciousness, and helpfulness in order to make this trip a great one.
