

COVID PROTOCOLS: Confirmed COVID cases in Lancaster Co. have increased from single digits/day on July 4 to 180 new cases/day. While a high percentage of our congregation is vaccinated, only 48% of the county is. This increases the odds for COVID to be brought into our church.
